Charlie:

I found your website asking for Bunnell landmarks.

As a descendent of Lydia Bunnell Mowry of Meshoppen, PA and the family responsible for cleaning up the old Solomon Bunnell cemetery on Rattlesnake (aka Bunnell Hill) in Meshoppen Township, Wyoming County PA, I write to advise of another Bunnell landmark that you may not know of.

On the crest of Bunnell hill, and above that old cemetery, there is a USGS datum plaque set in the stone of the pasture at the edge of the road. It is identified as the "Bunnell" marker.

I took a slide photo of the USGS plaque some years ago. It is marked Bunnell as the name of the NSGS location.

It is a bronze circular disc set flush in stone as most of this series are and is a technical reference survey marker, not a touristy sign for passersby. I have no idea how we first discovered it, except that perhaps there is a nearby standing sign that denotes the presence of the official marker.

**Bunnell House:** The Bunnell House stood where the Arlington Hotel is today, a popular spot for evening enjoyment. The **Bunnell Brothers** built this house (hotel) in 1868 replacing a wood framed hotel that was destroyed by fire. **Louis Potter** purchased the hotel in 1882 and changed it's name to the Arlington Hotel. The Arlington was the primary hotel and has been a local favorite tavern for over a 100 years now.

[Ed. Note: The hotel opened in June of 1868 and is still standing as the Arlington. In 1863 Stephen Bunnell was witness to a wedding in Bay County. The 1866/67 Indian and Pioneer History of the Saginaw Valley showed the M. and H. Bunnell & Co. grocers at 920 Water St. and H. Bunnell boarding at 219 First St.

In 1876, Ada Bunnell was enrolled in the 11<sup>th</sup> grade and Milie Bunnell was enrolled in the 9<sup>th</sup> grade. In the 1880 census I can only find Ada and Milie and their parents are born in NY. In the 1881 - 1882 Bay City Directory Catherine Bunnell is a cook at Mansion House, Milie Bunnell is a law student and boards at Campbell House, and Myron Bunnell is a Deputy U. S. Marshal and boards at Campbell House. Bottom line is that I have not been able to sort out for sure which Bunnell opened and operated the hotel in 1868 though I think it was likely Myron. There were also Bonnells living in the area.]

## Research Findings

From Ancestry.com, I found the following which was posted by PattiWoodward2063 (her Ancestry.com identification).

Will of **James Lusk** Lycoming Co., Pennsylvania written: 12 Feb. 1845

In the name of God amen, I **James Lusk** of the Township of Cascade in the county of Lycoming and the State of Pennsylvania being feeble in body but of perfect sound mind and memory do make and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following. To wit. First, I bequeath my soul to God who gave it. Second, It is will that after my decease my body be decently intered in a Christain like manner. I give and bequeath unto **my five children, Eleanor Border, May Green, Elizabeth Brewer, John Lusk and Samuel Lusk** the sum of two dollars each to be paid to them or to their legal representatives in one year after my decease by my executors. Fourth I

give and bequeath to my beloved **wife, Catherine**, the farm on which I now live, together with all the personal property now in my possession to have and to hold during her natural life and at her decease it is my will that the aforesaid farm and all personal property thereon be sold and the proceeds there of divided among **my ten children, Sarah Bonell, Martha Lusk, James Lusk, Henry Lusk, George W. Lusk, Abraham Lusk, William Lusk, Jane Lusk, Angeline B. Lusk, and Robert Lusk**, share and share alike. Fifth, It is my will that out of the portion due me from Elizabeth Lusk, desc., my just debts and funeral expenses be paid by my executors, as soon as sufficient funds shall come into their hands. And next that my executors shall out of said portion pay the purchase money and get from John Marshall Esq. the deed for the above mentioned farm. Sixth, It is my will that the one third of the overplus of my said portion be given to my beloved wife, Catherine, and the balance be divided among my ten childred last above mentioned, share and share alike, as they arrive respectively at the age of twenty-one years, together with the lawful interest which may arise on the said legacies and one year from the time of my decease. Seventh, It is my wish that all the children which are yet under age remain with their mother if possible, and if necessary that she draw the interest of their shares for assistance in their support. Eighth, I do appoint my esteemed friend, Samuel Bodine, and **my son-in-law, Abraham I. Bonnell**, Executors of this my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twelvth day of February One Thousand Eight Hundred and Forty-five.

[Ed. Note: Abraham Bonnell is 320190 in Claude's database. James Lusk appears to have been twice married with 5 children resulting from the 1<sup>st</sup> marriage and 10 resulting from the second marriage. At least that's my interpretation. I find this will interesting in that Bonnells and Lusks are mentioned together during the mid to late 1700s in Marjorie Gibbs research of the Kentucky tribe. Whether this Lusk line is at all related to the Lusks of KY is unknown. Claude's database shows that Sarah (Lusk) Bonnell was born in PA in 1826. Abraham's lineage is: William<sup>1</sup>, Nathaniel<sup>2</sup>, Isaac<sup>3</sup>, Abraham<sup>4</sup>, Abraham<sup>5</sup>, Clement<sup>6</sup>, Abraham<sup>7</sup>.]

[Ed. Note: The date of death would be 6 April 1901. Carrie Bunnell is the wife of Joseph Gilbert Bunnell, 330655 in Claude's data base. Mrs. May E. Hoyce should be Mrs. May E. Hoyle, daughter of Joseph and Carrie. Gilbert, Joseph, Chester and Carrie are also children of Joseph and Carrie. Not mentioned is their son Walter, who evidently was already deceased. Joseph Gilbert Bunnell's lineage is: William<sup>1</sup>, Benjamin<sup>2</sup>, Hezekiah<sup>3</sup>, Deliverance<sup>4</sup>, Jacob<sup>5</sup>, Sherman<sup>6</sup>, Joseph<sup>7</sup>, Joseph<sup>8</sup>.]

spoke of his sunny disposition and the pleasant words he always had for every one. He said that although in poor health and suffering from many disabilities, brought upon him while in the war, Mr. Bunnell never complained, and only his most intimate friends knew of his troubles. The services were conducted at the grave by Baldwin post, No. 6, G.A.R., and were very solemn and impressive. The pall bearers were Hon. H. H. Rockwell, Hon. Seymour Dexter, Lorenzo Howes, Edward Pickering, Joseph Roe and R. B. Van Gorder. The large concourse of people that attended his funeral showed the esteem in which Mr. Bunnell was held. Deceased was born at Westport, Fairfield county, Conn., February 23, 1829. His father's family moved to Guilford, Chenango county, N. Y., in 1835, and in 1860 he came to Elmira. The year following, at his country's call, he was one of the first to volunteer and enlisted in the Twenty-third regiment, Company K, New York State volunteers, serving until honorably discharged. After returning to Elmira he married Miss Caroline Mooers [sic]. Mr. Bunnell had resided in Elmira ever since the war, with the exception of a few years during Cleveland's first administration, when he was connected with the treasury department at Washington. During his residence here he served as a special policeman at different times, and was employed for a considerable length of time at Richardson's shoe factory. He was a shoemaker by trade. He was an active worker in politics, being a staunch Republican and quite prominent among the local workers of that party. Mr. Bunnell leaves to mourn his loss his wife, two daughters, Cora and Essie, and one son, Clayton; also two brothers, E. B. and Lewis G. Bunnell, both of Guilford, N. Y. His sudden death is a source of regret to a wide circle of friends.

I recently found out that my great-great-great grandfather, James Bunnell, is buried in Union Chapel Cemetery in Indianapolis (See James Bunnell under [www.findagrave.com](http://www.findagrave.com)). In December, I was able to visit the cemetery and verify that the birth date of James Bunnell is indeed March 27, 1780 and death date August 21, 1836. I do not know his parents names, but in the LDS records, [www.familysearch.org](http://www.familysearch.org), there is a James Bunnell listed with birth date of March 27, 1780 in New Jersey. His parents are listed as Daniel and Martha (Hughes) Bunnell. Unfortunately, no source is given. Since only the birth date, and not the death date, is listed; I can't help think that the source is not the tombstone but probably some birth or church records. Do you have any record of a James Bunnell being the son of Daniel? Thank you.

[Ed. Note: Also on the monument stone is: Elizabeth Bunnell (1789-1845). Elizabeth is the wife of James who was previously 019920 in Claude's database. There is a Daniel and Martha (Hughes) Bonnelli (300136) in the database but it does not show a son James. The dob of James would be 9 months after Daniel and Martha's marriage. Also note that Daniel went to OH where James also spent some time, though not the same counties. Also Daniel's father was named James. I shared this with Claude and he believes that James is the son of Daniel and Martha and has realigned James accordingly and assigned him a new ID

number of 310624. This is still circumstantial and we are asking if anyone has additional information to validate this.]


“Joseph Bonnell (04 Aug 1802 - 27 Sep 1840) was an unsung hero of the Texas Revolution. He was a West Point graduate (Class of 1825) and a member of The Long Gray Line.

His heroism in support of the War for Texas Independence is acknowledged in Texas House of Representatives Resolution #615 "Paying tribute to the life of Lieutenant Joseph Bonnell, hero of the Texas Revolution, and commemorating the placement of a historical marker at his grave site", which was adopted on 3/17/2005 by the 79th Texas Legislature. The resolution reads in part: "...he successfully quelled an uprising of 1,700 Caddo warriors through a peaceful negotiation with Caddo Chief Cortes; his efforts helped enable General Sam Houston to focus the full strength of his army on defeating Mexican troops led by Antonio Lopez de Santa Anna at the famed Battle of

San Jacinto, effectively securing the independence of the Republic of Texas."

Joseph Bonnell, First Lieutenant, 3rd Infantry Regiment, US Army, Fort Jesup, Louisiana, was an official witness to the US and Caddo Indian Treaty of July 1, 1835 in which the Caddo Indians sold all of

their lands in the United States to the United States. Lieutenant Bonnell asked to read the treaty before the chiefs signed and was refused by the US Agent. After the signing, it was discovered that the US Agent had included a hidden provision by which associates of the US Agent were enriched. Lieutenant Bonnell gave a deposition for the benefit of the Caddos which ultimately reached the US Supreme Court in *US v. Brooks*, 51 US 445 (1850).



Bonnell's integrity and character came to the attention of Major General Sam Houston of the Texas Army who asked Bonnell to be his Aide-de-Camp, an appointment approved by the government of Texas. Bonnell performed the duties of Aide by providing General Houston with a comprehensive report on how to organize and establish an army. General Houston recommended that Bonnell be commissioned as a Captain in the

Regular Army of Texas, and this was done by the government of Texas.

In March and April 1836, during the "Runaway Scrape," there were many reports of as many as 1,700 hostile Indians massing in East Texas. This threatened the security of General Houston's Army and the settlers in Texas. On April 7, 1836, US Major General Edmund P. Gaines, then commander of the southwest military division of the United States at Fort Jesup, Louisiana, ordered Bonnell to go into East Texas by himself to quell the Indian uprising.

Bonnell found the Indian villages empty except for women and children, the warriors having gone to the field. He finally located Caddo Chief Cortes and negotiated with him to have the warriors return to the villages in peace. Bonnell successfully completed his dangerous mission, which was of great benefit to General Houston and the Texas Army by allowing General Sam Houston to focus the full strength of his army on defeating Mexican troops led by Antonio Lopez de Santa Anna at the famed Battle of San Jacinto. Bonnell returned to Fort Jesup and wrote his report on April 20, 1836, the day before the Battle of San Jacinto.

The sword carried by General Houston in the Battle of San Jacinto was given to him by his friend, Joseph Bonnell. Bonnell had been in West Point with Texas Army Lieutenant William S. Stilwell who was with the "Twin Sisters" artillery at the Battle of San Jacinto. Bonnell was also at West Point with Albert Sidney Johnston, who later became Commanding General of the Texas Army and Secretary of War of the Republic of Texas when the new capital was built in Austin. In August 1836, three months after the Battle of San Jacinto, Sam Houston, Joseph Bonnell, and Albert Sidney Johnston were all in Nacogdoches, Texas.

Captain Joseph Bonnell, US Army, died on September 27, 1840 at the home of his brother in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. He was the only individual who was simultaneously an officer in the US Army and officer in the Texas Army."

[Ed. Note: Joseph Bonnell is 002442 in Claude's database. His lineage only extends back 3 generations: Robert<sup>1</sup>, Samuel<sup>2</sup>, Charles<sup>3</sup>, Joseph<sup>4</sup>.]

## Books

In the last issue, Chet Bunnell asked if someone could obtain a copy of *The Lynch and Robinson Families: Our Family Histories* by Edward Conover Lynch as there was supposed to be some mention of Bunnells as New England Colonists. John Grady, [grady.john1@gmail.com](mailto:grady.john1@gmail.com) or 4218 Oxhill Rd., Spring, TX 77388-5752 was able to locate a copy at the Clayton Genealogy Research Library in Houston. He was kind enough to copy the pages of interest and mail them to Chet and me.

I've read through it and was somewhat disappointed as it provided no primary or original sources. In fact there are parts of it that are patently untrue; for example a statement that William immigrated with two brothers. There has been no record found in New Haven of any Bunnell other than William at that time period.

His sources are extremely weak and it's a shame this was published as others will now reference it as though it is totally factual. His first source is the ancestral file of the LDS. I searched it and found 5 mentions of Thomas; in one case he was listed as born in Hondscoote, Yorkshire, England and in another in London, England. None of the entries provided a source, so I certainly would question their validity. The real issue is the question of Thomas being father of Benjamin and Benjamin being the father of William who emigrated to the colonies. His source for those statements is again the IGI which offers no proof or source. A couple of his other sources are e-mails posted on Genforum and the statements within those e-mails have no sources or references.

If you look through the IGI you will also see entries that William Bunnell and Ann Wilmot had 5 children, all born in England which does not match the data recorded by Donald Lines Jacobus.

While I was pleased we were able to read the applicable pages first hand and appreciated John obtaining them for us, my hopes for some new, exciting material were in vain.

## European Research

While the next two items are about Bo/Bunnells living in England long after most of our immigrant ancestors left England I believe that participating in these searches may eventually prove beneficial. Certainly there is as much chance to trace one of these lines back to our immigrant ancestor as there is finding our immigrant ancestor just by looking for his name in old records. Additionally, I keep hoping that we can convince one of the modern day English researchers to participate in our DNA program. It would really be exciting to find a living English Bo/Bunnell whose DNA matches one of our U.S. members.

I received an e-mail from Eric Bonell, [eric.bonell@talktalk.net](mailto:eric.bonell@talktalk.net), of Kent, UK. We had several e-mail exchanges and here is the gist of them:

“I have been researching the name Bonell & variations for over 25 years now.

My line I have traced back to 1807 in Warwick, UK, there I have reached the proverbial brick wall, as the church registers seem to have been lost.

My Emanuel Bonehill was born c1807, married 19 June 1837 in St. Mary's church, Warwick, Warwickshire, & had 3 children.

I have a tree programme on computer, it has now got over 5,500 names on it in all the branches & twigs, but only 39 Bonell/Bonehill's.

I have attached an Excel file I formed in 2007, which might be of interest to you.”

The spreadsheet he sent covers every Bu/Bo/Ba variation of Bonnell he could find in records for Yorkshire, Staffordshire and Warwickshire. For Yorkshire there are 700 line entries covering 1572 to 2004; Staffordshire has about 1885 entries covering 1362 to 2004; and Warwickshire has about 2500 entries from 1551 to 2004. By way of contrast my spreadsheet has fewer than 600 line entries. His is too large to print (several hundred pages), but I can e-mail a copy to whomever would like a copy. I have not tried to match the two spreadsheets up.

This is one of those e-mails that really piques ones interest; the writer described herself as the last of the Bunnells from Wales. So I'm immediately challenged to determine if that is true. Plus being from Wales is some what different. The writer is Lorna Bunnell, [lbunnell091285@hotmail.com](mailto:lbunnell091285@hotmail.com), of Yorkshire, UK and she wrote as follows last December.

“Hi ya,

I'm not sure whether you just stick to research in the US on the Bunnell family line. But I am the last in the Welsh line of Bunnells, so thought I'd get in touch with a brief summary of what I know of our family. My grandfather past away last weekend and whilst looking through some of his belongings I am interested to find out more about his past. Obviously starting in the US in a long shot. But thought I would get in touch.

There was some interesting newspaper cuttings about my grandfather "Edward David Arther Bunnell" spending a year in a turkish prison in 1952, stories of his father Arther (Ted) Bunnell, and his children, my grandad known as Dave, his sisters Daphnie, Joan and Lola. My grandad then married a scottish lady, Mary, whilst based in the RAF at Lossiemouth. They then had June (who has now remarried into the Bilinovich's, and lives in Ohio), David (my dad) and Debbie (Married into the Scottish family - Ingram) I believe he also had a second wife back in wales and had a daughter Claire. But I have no other information on the trail.

My names Lorna Bunnell, and as I say, I'm lead to believe I am the last in our Welsh line. I was just browsing the internet for more information on my grandads past, and thought I would send a quick message.

Love to all you fellow Bunnells, contine to keep the name alive!!!

Thank you

Lorna.”

Using Ancestry.co.uk as well as the U.S. Ancestry.com site, I was able to obtain considerable information including a copy of her grandfather's birth certificate from Wales, and make contact with the Daphne Bunnell cited above, who married a Leonard Yates in 1957 in Harwarden, Flintshire, Wales.. She was able to add substantial information as she has done some family research herself. I was also able to locate a granddaughter of Edward or more correctly the husband, Darren Low, of the granddaughter. He also provided some of the info used in building Lorna's Direct Line.

The birth certificate for Edward D.A. Bunnell (Lorna's grandfather) shows he was born October 13, 1933 at The Willows, Mancott Royal, Hawarden, Flint Co. Wales. His parents were Arthur and Florence (Wilson) Bunnell. Arthur was a Lance Corporal, 2<sup>nd</sup> Battalion, Royal Welch Fusiliers, living at The Willows, Mancott Royal.

I also found in the Ships Lists the fact that Arthur arrived back in Southampton, England on the ship Dempo, 25 September 1933 at the age of 24 (so he was born about 1909). His occupation is listed as soldier and the country of last permanent residence is Gibraltar. His proposed address in the log was The Willows-Mancot, Royal Queen's Ferry, Ches. Cheshire and Hawarden abut each other, so it appears some addresses straddled the border. Hawarden, Wales is about 7 miles from Chester, Cheshire which has often been mentioned as the home of our 17<sup>th</sup> century immigrant, William Bunnell.

I have also found an Arthur Bunnell, born in Tarvin, Cheshire abt 1886, who was in the Royal Welsh Fusiliers and was killed in action at Aldershot, 16 May 1915. He married a Helena May Talbot 13 May 1913. From census data it appears that this Arthur was the son of William and Harriet Bunnell. Daphne said that he was a great uncle of Arthur.

With the additional material from Ancestry.co.uk, from Daphne Yates, and from Darren LowI now have the family history back to about 1770 (See Direct Lines for Lorna). Daphne is trying to track down any living male Bunnell family members and then it is up to Steven and me to try and convince him to become one of our DNA participants.

Bottom line though is that the Welsh Bunnells were apparently from Cheshire. And, Lorna isn't the last of those Welsh Bunnells.

You are the closest match to my husband but your last name is Bunnell. I found this information a long time ago and I titled it Rockbridge VA information on Lusk family.

David Bonnell's middle name was Lusk, and David's son James P. Bonnell named his son, David Lusk Bonnell. Is this your family?

This sounded exciting at first - Lusks and Bu/Bonnells seem to be together in early PA, VA and TN. This implied there may have been an adoption. But closer examination showed that this match was at the 25 marker level. At the 37 marker level, we were so distant his name didn't even show up in a FTDNA supplied list.

## Post Script

I had been going to revisit all the information we have available on Thomas Bonnell who, according to Snell's *History of Sussex and Warren Counties, NJ*, emigrated to NJ from England. I have gone over it and I don't see anything really new. Recent findings such as Steve Bonnell's material on Thomas' daughter and son-in-law confirmed information that we previously had and provided more background. But the articles that William Austin wrote in Volumes VI and X still seem to capture what we currently know and don't know. So I'm going to leave Thomas alone for a while.
