*From the Editor:* As your new editor, I want to thank you for having faith enough, due mostly to the great job *William Austin* did, to renew your subscription another year. I have been researching many years and have met many very warm and friendly Bonnell and Bunnells while traveling. My husband is the Bonnell in the family and we began our research when his father died in 1986 and in his belongings found an obit from his great grandfather *Oliver BONNELL*, (who was *Oliver BUNNELL*, at birth in New Brunswick Canada in 1858.) I became very infected with the genealogy bug and have spread it to other members of my family and friends. We motorhome several times a year, driving one year from Washington State across the US to New Brunswick, Can., gathering information from Canada's National Archives and cemeteries while on the trip, which I will include in future issues for Canada researchers.

We travel about three or four months a year and gather information on the way. We are lucky enough to stop in Salt Lake City, Family History Library at least twice a year, once a year flying with my 'infected' sister in laws, including *Teri Bonnell*, your membership secretary. I have gathered information on all Bonnells/ Bunnells I see in records, as I couldn't connect mine until an unknown cousin, *Betsy David*, added to my chart and *Wm. Austin* and *Claude Bunnell* helped me a few years ago. So, I shouldn't run out of information to print for quite awhile. Although, I do encourage you to send in your own family information to share - there are probably many "cousins" reading this same paper anxious to share with you.

**Exchanging Information:**

We will try to alert others tracing the same names in the line and urge them to contact each other for exchanging information. You will see some changes in the Newsletter that you may not think are necessarily better, but different. As different editors are interested in new ideas to be shared, with little space to use, some things will be dropped to add new. We would like to try a few New things, and due to space will have to omit others, such as obits, and marriages unless the subjects were born over 70 yrs. ago. They are interesting, but as I said, we can't print it ALL. We do want to receive the obits and will keep them on file, hoping to make a obit package at the end of the year, or fill in space, if needed. I will send them, by request, to anyone, for the charge of postage and copies.. Please be patient with us and let us know what you like and don't like. We have had many suggestions and I will try to print most and implement some that seem worth doing or were suggested by several subscribers- This is *your family paper*, we need your input, your research and your ideas.

Please also remember this is new for us and though we have done much research, we've never before written a newsletter, other than our annual Christmas letter, and travel journals, and will make many mistakes. Please feel free to point them out to us (*tactfully, please*) *Throw in an 'Atta boy' once in awhile loo!*

**Sharing Research Information:**

Please send in information gathered. I have been asked many times, but the answer is; **I do not have William Austin's files-** Though, I am sure, should we have a question, he will be helpful in answering it. It would not be cost effective for him to copy all that he has acquired in 10 years and mail it to me, I am sorry to say. So if you already sent him your information - please also send me a copy.. It would be greatly appreciated.

We all have research we have collected over the years that didn't help us, but may help others in their research. *Claude Bunnell*, whom *William Austin* has mentioned many times in the newsletter, has a very large data base full of Bunnells of every spelling that he has collected over the years and has used proven sources, such as birth, death and marriage, etc. He has generously offered to answer queries for us and share his information. He asks that you *send him proven sources of Birth, Death, Marriage, etc. also, to add to his research/or sharing with the rest of us. Send queries to me, I will print them in the newsletter and forward them to him. He will send you (and me) a copy of his answer. But..... 1he query is for all of us to try to answer and add to. If we can.*

He has sent me a packet of Military and Land Index Records for Bonnell/ Bunnells and I will print as much as I can in the newsletter. There will be more than we can print, including information gathered in my own files and information sent in by you subscribers. Wm Austin printed much of the land records in 1996 Newsletter, *{for new subscribers info}* So, I am going to make room for *index to "Research Gathered"*, in each issue, so you can contact the newsletter, or the compiler of the information. I would like to encourage subscribers to contact each other and share information. There is an enormous pile of gathered information in our (we researchers) files that did us no good, but may be a major breakthrough for someone else.

We will try to leave room for suggestions sent in by subscribers. It will let the rest of us know what is of most interest and hopefully we can add to the newsletter with our research. Please feel free to send in Suggestions and ideas for the newsletter or Helpful Hints for researching, (*keeping them brief*)

Will be **FREE** to subscribers and printed as room permits, in the order they are received, per issue.. To non-subscribers, the cost will be 10 cents a word, with \$ 4.00 minimum. Please make your question clear, with as much information as you have to help answer your question - such as who married who, when, where. Also helpful to add middle names or initials and nicknames. ALWAYS include the State & County, if known. And still making it brief enough to allow room for others. As time permits, I will be sending your queries to *Claude BUNNELL*, as he has offered to check his data base, and will include your query, and his answer in the same issue - but.... anyone having more information is encouraged to answer it also, mailing your answer to us & author. **Please** include SASE if you would like a reply instead of waiting for the next issue.

**Mailing List & E-Mail:** I would like to send out a mailing list of subscribers, to include Computer E-Mail addresses.. If room in the newsletter or on request by members at the cost of printing and postage. ( 30 cents plus Stamped Self Addressed Envelope as of this mailing. This would only be for genealogy use, as a tool for research and NOT for a \* commercial mailing list for anyone to profit. E-Mail addresses will appear as I receive them in the Newsletter.

Anyone NOT wishing to be published on this list, and sent to other Bonnell/ Bunnell researchers, you should contact me. If I DO NOT hear from you, by March 15. I assume it is okay to put you on the list for others to contact.

### ***Pedigree Charts***

If you have a Bonnell/ Bunnell, Burnell, all spellings, in your line. please send *me* your pedigree chart to add to my files and I can shrink them down and print some each month in the newsletter. Since we aren't all up on geography - please also add the *state*, not just city and county when sending in ANY information to the newsletter. *Be sure to put your name & address on ALL pages sent to us.* The only way there will be room enough for all we wish to be included, without raising the cost of the paper, is to shrink some of it down before printing, If it is too small, take that page to a copy center and have it enlarged - or complain to me, and we will put less in the paper. But please send in the charts for my files.

Their 2 dtrs, Emily and Nancy moved to IL about 1850. Nancy mar. George Washington JOHNSON from, I believe VT. She was my GR GR Grandmother. Lorelia M. Brasche- 1115Beecher. Galesburg, IL 61401

Christian County, Illinois - Buckey Cemetery - Locust Township Section 32.

Buckey comprises an acre of land located in Locust township, three miles south and two miles west of Owaneco, IL. It is kept in excellent condition.

Early settlers from Ohio came to this place in 1852 naming it Buckeye Prairie for their native state. They organized a religious society about 1866.

The Cemetery is located on a hill south of the church. The 1880 Christian County History states that the first burial was a Murry child, (no dales given). A survey of the tombstones shows that Marion Hunter, an infant, was buried in 1852 and that Mary Ann. wife of Jacob Overholt. and infant, died in 1853.

Many early descendants of these early sellers are still living on Buckeye Prairie, maintaining the church and the burial grounds of Their pioneer forefathers.

Herod, Isaac, Kate--unmarried.

Harriet married SHEPPARD and had two children, names unknown.

Edna married MARKS, one child Belle.

Fanny died in early womanhood.

Helen married Bartholemew, one son Seabery.

Lindsey married, wife's name unknown. Three children--Alice the only one who lived.

Troy the youngest child had no children, last known of lived in Kansas.

Mary H. married Ben CLARK, had eight children: Snowden, Troy, Annetoinette, Seabery, Jonnie, Emma, Arabell, Mina.

Daniel married, name unknown. Seven children: Clara, Elara, Walter, Josephine, Maggie, Harry, Grace.

Wm. F. NUTTALL died March 31, 1917.


