PLEASE be sure to put your name & address on ALL pages sent to us. They get sorted to file, or put in the newsletter, and if they do get out of order - we need to know who they belong to. The

only way there will be room enough for all we wish to be included, without raising the cost of the paper, is to shrink some of it down before printing. If it is too small, take that page to a copy center and have it enlarged-or complain to me, and we will put less in the paper
But please send in the charts for my files.

Direct Lines & Information sent in for publication; As Genealogists and Family Historians, beginning or professional, we should *all prove* what we print or submit for printing. I, too, was under the mistaken idea that things printed in books, on paper and in the computer at LDS and Public Libraries was proven before submitted. I also had a set of parents for William Bunnell, our immigrant, with nothing to prove it. It upsets me now, to think of the family members I sent that chart to, eager to share my new hobby (Obsession!). I learned in a hurry, other things totally or partially wrong in the computers and books, as I had documented proof of these errors, some as close as my own grandmother. Then, I became a lot more cautious. Some charts I received from relatives were so far out of time and text, we chuckle about them often now, so do they. I have actually seen people in the library pick out a Surname and claim it as their relative, for no reason except that he was in the same area, at the right time with the same name. (They were either just beginning research or were just tired of getting no results from other searches.) Wish it were that easy.

I do not want to discourage you from sending me your Direct Lines or other information. But, if you are unsure of the Direct Line or Pedigree Chart and want help, send it onto William Austin, the past editor for 10 years, of this Newsletter, with 40 years of Bonnell/ Bunnell research behind him. He has helped me immensely.

Zethan, Edwin Fairbanks BUNNELL) Thanks to a hint given by Ruth Duncan. to a query my sisler, Alice Gedge, placed in the "Bunnell/Bonnell Newsletter (Vol. II, No. 2, April 1997. p. 1-2) we have finally, after more than a decade of searching, been able to locate the parents of Edwin Fairbanks BUNNELL. and with the help of past newsletters, been able to trace him back to the immigrant William.

Ruth suggested that he may be son of Zethan BUNNELL, who divorced his second wife Jerusha Hutchinson and went to Michigan. We have not yet traced Zethan. but have been able to prove Edwin's parentage by tracing his mother. Since no one that we have yet discovered has published this connection. I have enclosed some information in that regard. I hope you can use it.²²

1997 - Subscriber Answers to Previous Queries

Answers from William Austin

26 **Fall 97** - First, were John and Eva Coover Siblings? *ENGLISH AND ALLIED FAMILIES OF THE PINE CREEK VALLEY, LYCOMING CO. PA. compiled by Helen H. Russell, Jersey Shore. PA. in 1968, states on page 104 that Thomas Bonnell. b. 15 Jan. 1775. was married 15 Jan. 1802 to Eve Coover. His sister Sarah (Bonnell) married John Coover in 1808, and his sister Margaret (Bonnell) married Andrew Coover. It states further that all three Coovers were children of John Michael Coover, born November 1748, son of John Dietrich Coover (Kobar) who came to America on the THISTLE 29 August 1730. This is probably correct, but you should be warned that I have found many errors in Mrs. Russell's work.*

Benjamin Bunnell, the son of Solomon and Mary (Holdren) Bunnell, was born in 1742, not 1730. He was not the father of the John Bonnell who married Nancy (Betsy) Farrady. Benjamin's wife was Catherine Barry. Among their children was a son John Bunnell who married Mary Place and had 14 children. John and Mary were bom in Middle Smithfield twp, in what is now Monroe Co., PA. In the early 1820's they moved to a farm on the Susquehanna River near Tunkhannock in Luzerne (now Wyoming) Co., PA. They died and were buried there. They were my wife's great, great, great grandparents and had no known relationship to John Bonnell, father of Thomas Bonnell in your Query.

When I suggested to you that Thomas's son Benjamin Bonnell may have been the same person as your ancestor Benjamin P. Bunnell, it was only as a possibility, useful for further research. If you find this evidence. I hope you will share it with me. Of course if I come across any information which lends to strengthen the connection I will let you hww at once.



Clarence W. BONNELL -79, of 23 Laurel Ave., died Nov. 23, 1997, at his home. Born in Haverhill May 18, 1918, he was the son of the late Clarence E and Helena (GODFREY) BONNELL. He was the husband of Elvira A. (ELLERY) Bonnell, who died in 1990.

Mr- Bonnell attended school in Haverhill and graduated from Haverhill High School in 1939. He served with the US Army in Germany during World War II as a member of the 334th Infantry Battalion of the 84th Infantry Division.

He worked for the former Western Electric for 29 years before his retirement in 1972 as a lieutenant in plant security- For many years he and his family vacationed at Newfound Lake in New Hampshire and in 1973 he became manager of Wellington State Pond in Bristol. After retirement, he and his wife spent winters in Englewood, PL., where he collected shells and shark teeth- He was a member of Riverside Memorial Church and Merrimack Lodge F & AM.

The family includes three children: David W. BONNELL of Hudson. Judith BRISCOE of Englewood, FL., and Forrest BONNELL of Bradford: a brother, Robert BONNELL of Haverhill: 11 grandchildren and 12 great-grandchildren.

He was the father of William L. BONNELL, who died in 1937. Funeral: Dole, Childs & Shaw Funeral Home, 148 Main Street. Haverhill, NH. Burial at Linwood Cemetery "*Thanks for clipping to Clifton 'Kip' Cilley. Colebrook. NH. (Wouldn't it be nice if all obits contained so much information as this one!)*

FYI: The word "Huguenot" refers to the French Protestants in the seventeenth century. They were subject to intense prosecution by the Catholics who were supported by the royal family. Isaac & Hannah Bunaell's Children from William Austin

When Ruth Duncan published her book;- WILLIAM BUNNELL AND HIS DESCENDANTS in 1986, she included #81 Isaac Bunnell, son of Isaac, born 11 May 1759 in Derby, CT. She stated that Isaac appears in the 1790 census in Derby and in the 1800 census in Oxford, CT. This was not correct, since he died before 1790. His widow, Hannah (Tyier) Bunnell, appears in the 1790 Derby census.

Ruth listed four children for Isaac and Hannah (Tyier) Bunnell: dark. Charity, Isaac and Samuel S. Bunnell. Donald Lines Jacobus, in FAMILIES OF ANCIENT NEW HAVEN, listed only Clark, but noted that the family was incomplete. In her text Ruth noted that "the Oxford land records give fairly positive proof that Charity and Clark were sister and brother."

However, she did not include any notation to support her placement of Isaac and Samuel S. as children of Isaac and Hannah. I was reluctant to accept this placement without it, since I had been unable to discover any evidence of their parentage anywhere else.

After publication other book, Ruth sent me all her backup material. Her extensive abstracts of Connecticut land records were included. When I finally found the time to examine them, the reason for her conclusion became clear. I believe the information should be published, since no other evidence of the parentage for these two men has yet been found.

Isaac & Hannah Bunnell's Children by Wm. Austin - Continued

As noted above, Isaac Bunnell died before 1790. His widow Hannah died in April 1802 in Oxford, CT. Five real estate transactions abstracted by Ruth Duncan from the Oxford Land Records make the matter dear:

- Vol. 3, p. 192. Clark Bunnell of Oxford to Daniel Candee, Quit Claim land on Turnpike Road, north on Lewis Minot, west on Little River, south on David McEwen, being $\frac{1}{4}$ part of land and house 2 acres. 12 April 1804.
- Vol. 5, p. 226. Charity Bunnell of Oxford to Clark Bunnell of Watertown. **Quit Claim**, 2 acres in Oxford $\frac{1}{4}$ part of which descended to Charity from her father, deceased. The residence is owned by the other heirs, bounded north on Lewis Minot, east on David McEwen, south on McEwen, west on turnpike road. 23 November 1806.
- Vol. 4, p. 258. Samuel S. Bunnell of Kent to David McEwen and William Norris, $\frac{1}{4}$ part of undivided land in Oxford, north of meeting house, 2 acres with an undivided $\frac{1}{4}$ of house. North on Lewis Minot, southwest on Little River, southeast on David McEwen, northeast on Turnpike Road. 22 September 1807.
- Vol. 5, p. 237. Clark Bunnell of Watertown to Leverett Lines of Oxford, Quit Claim, 2 acres $\frac{1}{4}$ part of land together with $\frac{1}{4}$ part of house. North on Lewis Minot, east on Turnpike Road, south and west on David McEwen. 4 January 1808.
- Vol. 4, p. 478. Isaac Bunnell to Sally Lines, wife of Leverett Lines, land and house where Lines now lives, being $\frac{1}{4}$ part which descended to me from my mother Hannah Bunnell, late of Oxford, deceased. 17 April 1811.

Thus we see that after the death of Hannah, the property, 2 acres and a house in Oxford, was left in equal undivided shares to the four children.

Clark sold his share first to Daniel Candee in 1804. In 1806 Charity sold her share to her brother Clark. Samuel sold his share in 1807 to David McEwen and William Norris. Then in 1808 Clark sold the share he had bought from his sister to Leverett Lines. Finally, young Isaac sold his $\frac{1}{4}$ share in 1811 to Sally, wife of Leverett Lines. The Lines were living in the house by that time. Whether the Lines family acquired the other half share is not revealed in Ruth's abstracts.

Samuel S. Bunnell had a number of descendants, extending to the present day, and this evidence of his parentage is important to them. Isaac, Jr., on the other hand, died unmarried as a soldier in the War of 1812. However, his probate record is the only evidence that has turned up to identify the parents of Nathan Bunnell. In the probate record Nathan is termed uncle to the soldier Isaac, which has to mean that he was a previously unidentified son of Isaac and Ann (Collins) Bunnell. Nathan named his first son Isaac Coffins Bunnell, through whom there are many descendants.

We can be grateful to Ruth Duncan for her hard work in digging out this information.
